## **TYPICAL USE**

- Concentrated neutral detergent, water-based, non-ionic surfactants from natural origin.
- Used for regular cleaning, ordinary and extraordinary, for varnished, oiled and waxy wooden flooring.

## **BENEFITS**

- Delicate cleaning effect.
- Low foaming.
- ➡ It is not necessary to rinse and it does not make wooden surface opaque.
- ⇒ It can be used in cleaning machines, washer and dryer, and in high pressure washer.
- Free from phosphates.

## **APPLICATION METHOD**

#### Never use pure.

Before the application:

The tools must be clean.

### Application tools:

Cloth, mop, washer and dryer and high pressure washer.

#### Application:

- Ordinary cleaning: dilute 6 caps (use the plastic bottle cap) for 2 litres of water.
- ➡ Extraordinary cleaning: dilute 12 caps (use the plastic bottle cap) for 2 liters of water.
- Rub the surface with a rag (o with other tool) well squeezed.
- ⇒ If used in accordance with the instructions, it is not necessary the rinsing.
- **⇒** If used in high pressure washer, it is

- necessary remove the excess of liquid by a rag or by a wet vacuum cleaner.
- Pass over the surface a soft wool cloth or a brush polisher for restoring the original brilliance of floor; only if necessary and just on dry surface, anyway.

## **Tools cleaning:**

Rinse with water the tool to removing the detergent residues.

## WARNINGS

- Always dilute the product with water.
- Do not apply Lignum Pulix on the surfaces treated with Lignum Nature, before at least 30 days the oil application.

#### **STORAGE**

Keep only in original container. Keep container tightly closed. Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep cool. Keep away from heat. Protect from frost! Storage temperature: between +5° and +30°C. The shelf-life: 24 mouths from production. (see batch label on the pack).

#### **PACK SIZE**

- Plastic bottle PE 1 litre (Case Pack 12 units)
- Tank PE 5 litres (Case pack 4 units)
- ⇒ Tank PE 20 litres (Case pack 36 units)
