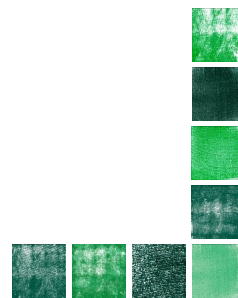


LIGNUM PULIX

CONCENTRATED NEUTRAL DETERGENT FOR WOODEN FLOORS



PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

- Lignum Pulix is a **concentrated neutral cleaner** containing naturally derived surfactants.
- For both **routine and deep cleaning**.

RECOMMENDED USE

Lignum Pulix is suitable for cleaning varnished, oiled or waxed wooden floors. For **indoor and outdoor** use.

COVERAGE

Coverage varies depending on the size of the stains and the level of cleaning required. We recommend always carrying out a test on a small area before use.

CHARACTERISTICS

- **Gentle and effective** cleaning action.
- **No rinsing** required.
- **Low foaming**.
- **Phosphate-free**.
- Contains **naturally derived** surfactants.
- Leaves the room **smelling pleasantly**.
- Can also be used in **scrubber-dryers** and **pressure washers**.

BEFORE APPLICATION

- The used **tools** must be **clean** (free of impurities or residues of other products).
- It is recommended to always carry out a preliminary test with the product before use.

TOOLS

Cloth, mop, scrubber-dryers or pressure washers.

METHODS OF APPLICATION

- **Never use** the product **undiluted**.
- For **routine cleaning**, dilute 1½ capfuls (using the jerrycan cap) or 3 capfuls (using the bottle cap) in every 2 litres of water.
- For **deep cleaning**, dilute 3 capfuls (using the jerrycan cap) or 6 capfuls (using the bottle cap) in every 2 litres of water.
- Rub the surface thoroughly with a well-wrung cloth (or other suitable tool). The product does not require rinsing if used in the recommended quantities.

- If cleaning with a pressure washer, remove any excess liquid with a cloth or a wet vacuum.
- Only if necessary (and only once the surface is dry), use a soft woollen cloth or a brush polisher to restore the floor's original shine.

IMPORTANT

- When treating surfaces with Lignum Nature or Lignum Easy, it is advisable not to use Lignum Pulix until at least 30 days have elapsed since the oil was applied.
- Wear gloves, goggles and protective clothing when using the product.

CLEANING OF TOOLS

Rinse with clean water after use.

PRODUCT STORAGE

Store the product in its original container, tightly closed, in a cool, well-ventilated place, away from sources of heat. Protect from frost! Storage temperature: between +5 °C and +30 °C. Shelf life: 48 months from the date of manufacture (see batch number on the packaging).

PACK SIZES

- 1-litre HDPE bottle (sales pack of 12 items)
- 5-litre PE jerrycan (sales pack of 4 items)
- 20-litre PE jerrycan (sales pack of 48 items)

Transport packaging is conditioned on eco-sustainable pallets, certified for wood sourced from PEFC-certified managed forests.
